## <u>GD2019-04-M, IN THE MATTER OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 2019 CLEAN</u> ENERGY DC OMNIBUS ACT COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS,

- 1. By this Notice, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia ("Commission") invites interested persons to comment on the draft benefit-cost analysis model ("BCA Model") and to submit questions limited to the mechanics and use of the Model within 45 days from the date of this Notice. Reply comments may be filed within 15 days thereafter.
- 2. In Order No. 21938, the Commission reviewed the Clean Energy Act Implementation Working Group's ("CEAIWG") Report and Recommendations on the development of a standardized benefit-cost analysis framework for the Commission. The Commission adopted several of the CEAIWG's Recommendations and opened a two part Phase 2 of this proceeding. The Commission held that in Phase 2, Part A, it will develop a standardized Societal Cost Test ("SCT") and Total Resource Cost Test ("TRC") framework within six months from the date a contract is executed between the Commission and its consultants. The developed model was directed to be further refined in Phase 2, Part B, within 12 months from the date a contract is executed between the Commission and its consultant.
- 3. The draft BCA Model has been completed by the Commission's consultants, Energy Shrink, LLC, and Energy and Environmental Economics, Inc. An inactive draft BCA Model was filed on February 18, 2025, in Docket GD-2019-04-M, which included a link to a working draft Model posted on the Commission's website that same day. The BCA Model Guidebook, which provides user guidance for the BCA Model and the methodology and calculations used in the Model for Part A, was filed previously in Docket No. GD-2019-04-M on January 31, 2025.
- 4. In order for stakeholders and other interested persons to obtain a better understanding of the draft BCA Model prior to the submission of comments, Commission Staff and the Commission's consultants conducted a Technical Conference on February 20, 2025, to discuss the draft Model and to respond to questions from stakeholders and other interested persons.
- 5. Interested persons may now file comments on the draft BCA Model and may submit questions limited to the mechanics and use of the draft Model within 45 days from the date of this Notice. Reply Comments are due 15 days thereafter. Comments and questions should be filed
