## **Commission Open Meeting**

The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (Commission) approved two actions items before the Commission at its February 27, 2019 Open Meeting. The matters include:

1. [Formal Case No. 1017, In the Matter of the Development and Designation of Standard Offer Service in the District of Columbia.](#) This Order approves the Potomac Electric Power Company's revised proposed retail rates, including the administrative charges, for Standard Offer Service ("SOS") filed January 25, 2019. Pepco shall file a revised tariff setting forth the new retail rates for SOS within seven (7) calendar days of the date of this Order.
2. [Formal Case No. 1130, In the Matter of the Investigation into Modernizing the Energy Distribution System for Increased Sustainability.](#) This Order directs the Potomac Electric Power Company to have funds in the amount of \$76,904.38 disbursed from the Modernizing the Energy Deliver System for Increased Sustainability ("MEDSIS") Pilot Project Fund Subaccount, created as a condition of the approval of the PHI-Exelon Merger, to Smart Electric Power Alliance for the provision of consulting services for Phases 1 and 2 of the MEDSIS Initiative within 15 days of the date of this Order.
