OPEN MEETING SUMMARY

Wednesday, July 29, 2020

The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia approved six Formal Case action items at its July 29, 2020, Open Meeting:

FORMAL CASE ACTIONS

1. Formal Case No. 1154, In the Matter of Washington Gas Light Company's Application for Approval of PROJECTpipes 2 Plan. This Order denies Washington Gas Light Company's Motion to Strike the Sierra Club's Direct Testimony and Exhibits filed on June 15, 2020.

The next three (3) matters are in Formal Case No. 1162, In the Matter of the Application of Washington Gas Light Company for Authority to Increase Existing Rates and Charges for Gas Service.

- 2. The first Order denies the Office of the Peoples Counsel's (OPC's) Motion to Compel filed June 5, 2020.
- 3. The next Order grants in part and denies in part OPC's Motion to Compel filed June 17, 2020.
- 4. The last Order grants OPC's Motion to Compel filed June 26, 2020.
- 5. **ASMT 2020, Assessments for Fiscal Year 2020**. These Orders assess public utility companies, competitive local exchange carriers, competitive natural gas suppliers and competitive electric suppliers for their percentages of the Commission's and OPC's Fiscal Year 2020 appropriated budget as directed in the Orders.
- 6. **GT00-2, In the Matter of Washington Gas Light Company's Rights-of-Way Surcharge General Regulations Tariff, P.S.C.-D.C. No. 3.** This Notice of Final Tariff ("Notice") approves Washington Gas Light Company's Rights-of-Way Fee Surcharge which shall become effective upon publication of this Notice in the D.C. Register.
