### NOTICE OF PUBLIC INTEREST HEARING

**FORMAL CASE NO. 1057, IN THE MATTER OF VERIZON WASHINGTON, D.C. INC.'S PRICE CAP PLAN 2007 FOR THE PROVISION OF LOCAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA**

The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia ("Commission") hereby specifies the process for participation in the public interest hearing regarding the Joint Motion for Approval of Unanimous Settlement filed by Verizon Washington, DC Inc. and the Office of the People's Counsel of the District of Columbia in the above-captioned proceeding on March 13, 2008.<sup>1</sup> The public interest hearing will convene beginning Thursday, May 15, 2008, at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, 1333 H Street, N.W., Suite 700, East Tower, Washington, D.C. 20005. Interested persons wishing to participate in the hearing are directed to file a petition to intervene in accordance with section 106 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure within ten (10) days of the publication of this Notice in the *D.C. Register*. Interested persons must also file written statements or comments regarding the proposed settlement agreement if they wish to participate in the hearing. These written statements must be filed with the Commission Secretary's Office within ten (10) days of the publication of this Notice in the *D.C. Register*. The Commission also notifies interested persons that they may be subject to cross-examination by the parties at the hearing.
