

With respect to FC 1119, the Exelon/Pepco Merger Application, please be advised that due to the unusually large volume of comments and letters that the Commission has received from DC residents expressing their views on the merger, we have decided to post those comments and letters on e-Docket in large groups, sometimes 50 or more, as opposed to our usual method of posting each letter and comments individually on e-Docket. The batching process allows the Office of the Commission Secretary to more efficiently upload the large volume of comments being received and the Commission's acknowledgement that the comments have been received. In order to locate specific comments or a letter, please follow the instructions below to search for and access specific comments or a letter by the name of the filer.

Instructions:

On our website, please select “e-Docket System” and click on “Search Current Dockets”. Once the “Search Current Dockets” anchor page opens, input the name in which you are searching for in the “Company/Individual Filing” or “Keyword” field. As a visual example, these areas have been highlighted in yellow below:
