FORMAL CASE ACTIONS

- 1. Formal Case No. 1160, In the Matter of the Development of the Metrics for Electric Company and Gas Company Energy Efficiency and Demand Response Programs Pursuant to Section 201(B) of the Clean Energy DC Omnibus Amendment Act of 2018** – This Order grants the Department of Energy and Environment’s Motion for Clarification of Order No. 20654.
- 2. OPC2020-02, Office of the People’s Counsel for the District of Columbia’s Motion to Compel Discovery Response from Washington Gas Light Company** – This Order denies the Office of the People’s Counsel’s Petition for Reconsideration of Order No. 20628.
