



## Commission Open Meeting Summary

May 27, 2020

The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia approved five action items at its May 27, 2020 Open Meeting. The matters include:

### I. **Formal Case Actions:**

1. [Formal Case No.977, the Order regarding Washington Gas Light Company's Natural Gas Quality of Service Standards Annual Report for Calendar Year 2019](#). Order No. 20359, accepts Washington Gas Light Company's Natural Gas Quality of Service Standards annual report for calendar year 2019 as filed.
2. [Formal Case No. 988, the Order regarding Verizon Washington, DC Inc.'s Request for DC Universal Service Trust Fund Funding Application for the First Quarter of 2020](#). Order No.20356, grants Verizon Washington DC's request for DC Universal Trust Fund funding for the first quarter.
3. [Formal Case No. 1125, the Order regarding the District Department of Energy and Environment's Invoices for the Second Quarter FY 2020](#). Order No.20357, approves the District Department of Energy and Environment's invoices for the second quarter FY 2020.
