Commission Open Meeting

The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (Commission) approved one actions items before the Commission at its January 16, 2019 Open Meeting. The matters include:

Formal Case No. 1154, Application of Washington Gas Light Company for Approval
of PROJECTpipes 2 Plan. This Order grants in part and denies in part the Office of the
People's Counsel's ("OPC") Motion for Enlargement of Time. The Commission grants
OPC's Motion for Enlargement of Time but denies OPC's request for an additional 90
days to file comments and reply comments. The Commission extends the comment
period an additional 60 days to March 22, 2019, and the reply comment period to April
8, 2019.

Announcements:

The Commission will convene a Community Hearing following its 2:00 pm February 6, 2019, Open Meeting on Formal Case No. 977, to discuss the community's concerns related to natural gas leaks.
