Climate Action, Baltimore-Washington Construction and Public Employees Laborers' District Council, Tesla, Inc., Small Business Utility Advocates, and DC Consumer Utility Board and Solar United Neighbors on April 17, 2018, in *Formal Case Nos. 1150 and 1151*<sup>2</sup> is **CANCELLED**.
