The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) hereby gives notice that the Commission will hold a PJM Capacity Auction Task Force (“Task Force”) meeting on Tuesday, May 6, 2025, from 2:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. via Microsoft Teams.
