PUBLIC NOTICE

FORMAL CASE NO. 1017, IN THE MATTER OF THE DEVELOPMENT AND DESIGNATION OF STANDARD OFFER SERVICE IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

1. The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) hereby gives notice that on July 29, 2026, the Potomac Electric Power Company (“Pepco”), acting in its role as the Standard Offer Service (“SOS”) Administrator, filed, on behalf of the SOS Working Group, the proposed Wholesale Full Requirements Service Agreement (“WFRSA”) and Request for Proposals (“RFP”) for the 2026-2027 SOS solicitation pursuant to 15 DCMR § 4101.3.¹

2. On June 30, 2026, Pepco, as the SOS Administrator, convened an SOS Working Group meeting to discuss changes to the 2026-2027 SOS RFP and WFRSA. Prior to the submission of the RFP and WFRSA for the upcoming SOS solicitation, Pepco convenes the SOS Working Group to consider whether and to what extent the WFRSA and RFP should be revised or updated. Each year by August 1, the SOS Administrator must file a WFRSA and RFP for the upcoming SOS solicitation.²

3. In its July 29, 2026, filing, Pepco proposes three (3) changes to the RFP and five (5) changes to WFRSA.

4. Pepco proposes the following changes to the 2026-2027 RFP:

- a. Section 2.1 advises suppliers to incorporate a capacity proxy price of \$329.35 into their offers to supply Residential and Small Commercial full-requirements wholesale service for each month in the contract term that the Zonal Net Load Price for capacity resulting from the BRA is unknown at the time suppliers provide their offers in an SOS auction. For Tranche 1, suppliers will use the proxy price for 29/30. For Tranche 2, suppliers will not have a proxy price and

will use 29/30 BRA results, only barring any changes to the Capacity auction schedule posted on PJM’s website.³

- b. In Section 2.1, Pepco revised the below language to reflect there will be no changes to the upcoming 2026-2027 SOS procurement as a result of Order No. 22702 approving Pepco’s PPA. “On August 14, 2025, the Commission issued Order No. 22702 approving Pepco’s proposed SOS Renewable energy power purchase agreement (“PPA”) for 5 percent of SOS energy. Delivery of energy from the approved PPA project is expected to begin in December 2027. SOS auctions beginning in December 2027 for Delivery Years 2028-2029 and beyond will be adjusted accordingly. There will be no impact on the upcoming auctions scheduled for December 7, 2026, and January 4, 2027.”⁴
 - c. Appendix A, revised implementation timeline.⁵
5. Pepco proposes the following changes to the 2026-2027 WFRSA:
- a. Article 7.1 updated the proxy capacity price for suppliers to incorporate a price of \$329.35 per megawatt-day into their offers to supply full-requirements wholesale service.⁶
 - b. Exhibits A, B1 & B2 Transaction Confirmations have been updated to include the Pnode Delivery Point for Pepco DC.⁷
 - c. Exhibit C and Exhibit C-1 were updated to include the paragraph below to the Bid Assurance Letter of Credit and Performance Assurance Letter of Credit.
 - i. “IN ADDITION TO THE PROCEDURE DESCRIBED ABOVE FOR THE PHYSICAL PRESENTATION TO US OF YOUR DOCUMENT(S), YOU HAVE THE OPTION TO PRESENT SUCH DOCUMENTS TO US AS A PDF ATTACHMENT TO AN EMAIL SENT FROM BENEFICIARY’S EMAIL DOMAIN [INSERT BENEFICIARY EMAIL]. EACH PRESENTATION OF A PDF ATTACHMENT TO AN EMAIL TRANSMISSION SHALL BE MADE TO US AT [INSERT ISSUER EMAIL], AND SHALL ALSO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING CERTIFICATION BY YOU TO US: “WE CERTIFY THAT (1) WE ARE THE BENEFICIARY OF THE LETTER OF CREDIT INDICATED IN THE PDF ATTACHMENT(S) AND (2) EACH DOCUMENT WE HAVE TRANSMITTED OR OTHERWISE PRESENTED TO YOU VIA

- d. Exhibit E will be updated to reflect the current Billing Line Item list from PJM.⁹
- e. Pepco proposes to have Billing Line Item 1935 in Exhibit E be transferred to the utility, which would require suppliers who are currently serving load to obtain a new short name for future load.¹⁰
