**FORMAL CASE NO. 1134, IN THE MATTER OF THE INVESTIGATION INTO THE
PROCUREMENT COST ADJUSTMENT FOR STANDARD OFFER SERVICE**

The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) hereby gives notice that the Commission will hold the third Procurement Cost Adjustment (“PCA”) Technical Conference on Thursday, August 1, 2019. In accordance with Commission directives in Order No. 18064, the Commission will continue its investigation into the Potomac Electric Power Company’s (“Pepco”) determination of the PCA for Standard Offer Service (“SOS”). The third Technical Conference will be held from 11:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the Commission’s Phylcia Fautleroy Bowman Conference Room – 1325 G St., N.W., Suite 800, Washington, D.C. 20005.

At the second Technical Conference held on June 13, 2019, Pepco made a power point presentation on: 1) how the PCA used in the District of Columbia differs from the PCA used in Delaware by Delmarva Power & Light Company; 2) what the advantages and disadvantages of resetting the PCA annually are; and 3) how the District of Columbia’s SOS PCA could be converted to resetting annually. On July 15, 2019, Pepco filed, in response to a Commission staff request at the June 13, 2019, Technical Conference, further information demonstrating the effects of transitioning from a monthly PCA calculation and rate to an annual PCA. In the third Technical Conference, the Commission seeks final recommendations on how, precisely, to reform the PCA methodology and calculations.
