

PEPCO NOTICE OF COMMUNITY ADVISORY GROUP ASSEMBLY WATERFRONT SUBSTATION – BUZZARD POINT

In order to inform and educate the community regarding the construction and operation of the future Waterfront Substation on Buzzard Point in the Southwest section of the District of Columbia, Potomac Electric Power Company (Pepco) is convening a Community Advisory Group (CAG).
