The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia ("Commission") hereby gives notice that the Commission will hold the fourth Technical Conference on Monday, November 25, 2019, to discuss the Procurement Cost Adjustment ("PCA") for Standard Offer Service ("SOS"). In accordance with Commission directives in Order No. 18064, the Commission will continue its investigation into the Potomac Electric Power Company's ("Pepco") determination of the PCA for SOS. The fourth Technical Conference will be held from 12:30 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. in the Commission's Phylicia Fauntleroy Bowman Conference Room – 1325 G St., N.W., Suite 800, Washington, D.C. 20005.

In the fourth Technical Conference, the Commission seeks to get consensus on how to reform the PCA methodology and calculations, including what methodology to employ to eliminate the deferred balance in the PCA, total impact of switching from monthly PCA to annual PCA, estimated customer impact, and planned next steps.
