**PUBLIC NOTICE OF CYBERSECURITY BRIEFING**

**June 6, 2025**

1. Through this Public Notice, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) schedules a Cybersecurity Conference to discuss, among other topics, best practices that the electric and natural gas utilities are taking to protect their infrastructures from cybersecurity threats. The conference is scheduled for Wednesday, July 16, 2025, at 11:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room.

2. The Commission will hear from the Potomac Electric Power Company (“Pepco”) and Washington Gas Light Company (“WGL”) on topics including each company’s cyber risk management programs, public notification methods when breaches occur, and reporting structures for cybersecurity attacks on their information networks and control systems.
