**NOTICE OF AGENCY FUND REQUIREMENTS**

**January 27, 2025**

**FORMAL CASE NO. 1017, IN THE MATTER OF THE DEVELOPMENT AND  
DESIGNATION OF STANDARD OFFER SERVICE IN THE DISTRICT OF  
COLUMBIA,**

1. The instant matter is an active proceeding before the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) regulating the provision of Standard Offer Service (“SOS”) for electricity in the District of Columbia in *Formal Case No. 1017*.

2. Pursuant to D.C. Code § 34-912 (a), the Commission is authorized to assess a public utility for “its expenses arising from any investigation, valuation, revaluation, or proceeding of any nature by the Commission.”<sup>1</sup> In view of the issues that must be examined in this proceeding, the Commission has estimated the necessary and reasonable expenses that it will incur in the discharge of its regulatory responsibilities to be \$200,000. These responsibilities include the retention of consultants to review and evaluate SOS matters and all issues relating to this case, including technical issues, and the eventual drafting and issuing of reports, orders, and rulemakings relating to the Commission’s findings on SOS matters. Various expenses such as photocopying, messenger fees, and other administrative expenses may also be incurred.

3. The Commission hereby gives notice, pursuant to 15 DCMR § 1401, that the estimated assessment to the Potomac Electric Power Company (“Pepco”) is \$200,000, payable in one installment.<sup>2</sup> If Pepco or any other interested persons desire to file comments on the proposed assessment, they may do so within five (5) business days of the date of the issuance of this Notice. After that time, the Commission will take final action regarding this assessment.
