**NOTICE OF INQUIRY**

**October 22, 2025**

**FORMAL CASE NO. 1050, IN THE MATTER OF THE INVESTIGATION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF INTERCONNECTION STANDARDS IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,**

1. By this Notice of Inquiry, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) requests input from stakeholders about potential temporary solutions for expedited interconnection of DER due to the sunseting of the investment tax credit (“ITC”) at the end of this calendar year. The request is based on a tiered prioritization framework that focuses resources on the projects facing the most immediate deadlines. This issue was raised in a technical conference in the instant case on July 15, 2025.<sup>1</sup>

2. We request that interested stakeholders file comments addressing the questions below.

1. For Pepco: provide the total number of projects in the queue and the total amount of pending capacity at each interconnection level broken down by the level of urgency based on the timing of the ITC expiry date and include a proposed action plan to mitigate the impact of expiring federal incentives..

2. For interested stakeholders: Should the Commission issue a temporary directive to allow for some form of expedited interconnection of projects in the queue through the end of this year, in a manner that protects the safety and reliability of the distribution system? If yes, describe potential solution(s) in detail.

3. Persons interested in commenting on the issues presented above shall file their comments no later than October 31, 2025. Comments may be filed with Brinda Westbrook-
