**NOTICE OF RESCHEDULING OF DATE FOR KICKOFF WORKSHOP IN
FORMAL CASE 1130 TO OCTOBER 1**

**FORMAL CASE NO. 1130, IN THE MATTER OF THE INVESTIGATION INTO
MODERNIZING THE ENERGY DELIVERY SYSTEM FOR INCREASED
SUSTAINABILITY**

1. On June 12, 2015, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) opened this proceeding to identify technologies and policies that can modernize our energy delivery system for increased sustainability and make it more reliable, efficient, cost-effective and interactive.¹ At that time, the Commission invited the public to file initial comments on the preliminary scope of the proceeding and discuss whether and to what extent the scope of this proceeding should be expanded or refined.² Also, the Commission announced that it would hold a Kickoff Workshop for interested persons on September 22, 2015, to set out an initial overview of the current energy distribution system in the District and to discuss the future plans for this Commission investigation. Due to the fact that September 22 is the start of Yom Kippur, the Kickoff Workshop scheduled on that day will be rescheduled for October 1, 2015, at 10:00 AM in the Commission’s Hearing Room at 1325 G Street, N.W., Suite 800, Washington, D.C. 20005.
