The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia ("Commission") hereby gives notice that, pursuant to Order No. 22390, from 10:00 AM to 12:30 PM on Tuesday, March 3, 2026, the Commission will convene a technical conference in the Commission's Hearing Room to discuss the Potomac Electric Power Company's Standby Service – Rider S proposal.¹ The technical conference shall be hybrid in nature permitting in-person and virtual participation.
