**CHANGE IN BILL STABILIZATION ADJUSTMENT TECHNICAL CONFERENCE  
FROM JANUARY 7, 2022 TO JANUARY 20, 2022**

**January 3, 2022**

1. The third Bill Stabilization Adjustment (“BSA”) Technical Conference originally scheduled to be convened on January 7, 2022, in accordance with the Commission’s Notice dated November 8, 2021, has been rescheduled and will instead be convened on Thursday, January 20, 2022 from 10:00 a. m. to 1:00 p.m.

2. This third Technical Conference will focus on the need for enhancements of the BSA including:

- (a) process improvements – both short-term and longer term;
- (b) BSA mechanism and continued energy efficiency gains;
- (c) BSA mechanism and volatility related to material changes in economic activity, potential electrification, and material changes to weather;
- (d) enhancements in BSA deferral mechanism;
- (e) enhancements in BSA internal controls and compliance reporting;
- (f) alternative ratemaking approaches (*i.e.*, separate surcharge/surcredit); and
- (g) timing and scope of upcoming BSA audit.

3. Pepco is to provide relevant background materials for this technical conference at least three (3) days prior to the conference. Parties can also provide supplemental presentations to address the issues for the third technical conference. The technical conference will be facilitated and hosted by Commission Staff and will convene virtually *via* Webex on Thursday, January 20, 2022, commencing at 10:00 a.m. By February 17, 2022, Pepco is to file a report with the Commission explaining any proposals and recommendations made by Pepco and the Parties at the conference and a final or consensus recommended course of reforming the BSA.<sup>1</sup> If the Parties

fail to achieve a consensus recommended course of action, any Party may file its recommendations within 15 business days of the filing of Pepco's report.

4. The Commission will initiate a WebEx invite to the Parties who plan to participate prior to January 20, 2022.
