**NOTICE OF RATE DESIGN WORKING GROUP MEETING**

**FEBRUARY 12, 2025**

**FORMAL CASE NO. 1176, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF THE  
POTOMAC ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY FOR AUTHORITY TO IMPLEMENT A  
MULTIYEAR RATE PLAN FOR ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION SERVICE IN THE  
DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA**

1. This Notice informs the Parties and interested persons that the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) Staff will convene the Rate Design Working Group (“RDWG”) meeting on Wednesday, February 12, 2025, from 2:00-4:00 PM in the Commission’s 8<sup>th</sup> Floor Hearing Room.

2. In Order No. 22328, the Commission determined more details are needed to evaluate the impact of Time of Use (“TOU”) rates on customer usage, grid constraints, and clean energy technologies. The Commission also noted that there was insufficient rationale for Pepco’s proposed peak rate hours and, therefore, rejected Pepco’s TOU proposal. As a result, the Commission directed the RDWG to convene within 90 days of the date of the Order to review and discuss the proposed rate structure and to submit a report to the Commission by July 31, 2025, identifying consensus and non-consensus items.<sup>1</sup>

3.
