

PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA**PUBLIC NOTICE OF VIRTUAL COMMUNITY HEARING****FORMAL CASE NO. 1180, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF WASHINGTON GAS LIGHT COMPANY FOR AUTHORITY TO INCREASE EXISTING RATES AND CHARGES FOR GAS SERVICE,**

1. On August 5, 2024, Washington Gas Light Company (WGL) filed an Application requesting authority to increase existing rates and charges for gas service in the District of Columbia.¹ The requested rates are designed to collect approximately \$257.2 million in total revenue, representing a \$45.6 million increase in weather-normalized annual revenue. This includes the transfer of \$11.7 million in costs associated with natural gas system upgrades previously approved by the Commission (PROJECTpipes). The net increase in new revenues is \$33.9 million, reflecting an approximate 11.9% increase over current rates. If granted in full, the average bill increase for residential sales heating and cooling customers based on an annual usage of 627 therms would be \$15.33 or 17.63%.

2. On March 7, 2025, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (Commission) provided notice of three community hearings to solicit community input on WGL's Application.² The community hearings are scheduled for: April 10, 2025, at Benning (Dorothy I. Height) Neighborhood Library, 3935 Benning Road, NE, Meeting Room 1, from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.; April 21, 2025, at Petworth Neighborhood Library, 4200 Kansas Avenue, NW, Meeting Room 1, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.; and April 29, 2025, in the Commission Hearing Room at 1325 G Street, NW, Suite 800, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Through this Public Notice, the Commission provides instructions on virtual participation at the April 29, 2025, 6:00 p.m. community hearing held in the Commission Hearing Room. The Commission cannot accommodate virtual participation at the April 10, 2025, and April 21, 2025, community hearings. Hearing and Post Hearing

All participants must ensure audio remains muted until requested to testify by OCMS.

OCMS will acknowledge/announce the participant using the name that appears on-screen. Once the participant has been recognized, OCMS will unmute the microphone.

Individuals or organizations will be called to speak in the order they appear on screen. Should a participant not be present when called upon, the person will be passed, and the next participant will be called. After the list of virtual participants has been exhausted, OCMS will recall those participants previously passed.
