MODERNIZING THE ENERGY DELIVERY SYSTEM FOR INCREASED  
SUSTAINABILITY;**

**FORMAL CASE NO. 1155, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF THE  
POTOMAC ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY FOR APPROVAL OF ITS  
TRANSPORTATION ELECTRIFICATION PROGRAM,**

1. On March 10, 2023, the Public Service of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) issued Order No. 21579, which, among other things, directed the Commission Staff to convene a technical conference within 60 days of the date of Order No. 21579 to discuss (1) whether Pepco’s General Terms and Conditions for Furnishing Electric Service in the District of Columbia, Section 10 (a) should be amended to exclude ownership by the Potomac Electric Power Company (“Pepco”) of behind the meter electric vehicle charging make-ready infrastructure and (2) the concerns of the Department of Energy and Environment (“DOEE”) and the Office of the People’s Counsel for the District of Columbia (“OPC”) about a lack of transparency and whether distribution upgrades to accommodate electric vehicle charging have been justified.

2. The Commission Staff will convene the Technical Conference on Tuesday, May 2, 2023, at 1:00 p.m., conducted in person and virtually in the Commission’s 8<sup>th</sup> Floor Hearing Room. Participants should be prepared to discuss whether and to what extent Pepco’s General Terms and Conditions for Furnishing Electric Service in the District of Columbia, Section 10 (a), should exclude ownership by Pepco of BTM make-ready infrastructure. DOEE and OPC should be prepared to discuss their concerns about excluding distribution system upgrades and funding transparency and their recommendations to the Commission. Participants will be provided an opportunity to comment on the DOEE and OPC concerns and recommendations.

3.
