We are interested in hearing ideas of how to better enable the deployment of DERs throughout the District. Suggested high-level topics may include*:

- Safety/Ownership/Operation/Maintenance Structure
- Public Right-Of-Way, Existing Tunnel Systems
- Obligation to Serve
- DC Code § 34–1516 -> “No person shall construct an electric generating facility for the purpose of the retail or wholesale sale of electricity unless the Commission first determines, after notice and a hearing, that the construction of the electric generating facility is in the public interest.”
- Sustainable Business Models (tools or data for assessing costs and benefits that currently are not available), Win-Win Developer-Utility Propositions
- Interconnection, Technical Requirements imposed by utilities, Adequacy of existing utilities infrastructure
- Contractual Models for exporting facilities interested in supplying the utilities’ service territory with capacity and/or ancillary services
- Distribution System Visibility, Distributed Resource Planning

*A later date follow-up Workshop is sought to focus on common themes brought up by the DER developers.
