## FORMAL CASE NO. 1130, IN THE MATTER OF THE INVESTIGATION INTO MODERNIZING THE ENERGY DELIVERY SYSTEM FOR INCREASED SUSTAINABILITY

The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (Commission), in conjunction with its consultant, Smart Electric Power Alliance (SEPA), invites the general public to participate in a two-day joint working group meeting involving all of the working groups formed in the Modernizing the Energy Delivery System for Increased Sustainability (MEDSIS) Initiative.

The purpose of the two-day joint working group meeting is to facilitate stakeholder and public input on the draft MEDSIS working group recommendations which will be released to the public on Friday, April 12, 2019. The workshop will take place on Thursday, April 25, 2019, and Friday, April 26, 2019, from 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. in the Commission's Hearing Room, located at 1325 G Street N.W., Suite 800 Washington, D.C. 20005.

Last year the Commission formed six (6) working groups in the MEDSIS Initiative which include: Pilot Projects, Non-Wire Alternatives, Data and Information Access and Alignment, Microgrids, Future Rate Design, and Customer Impact. These working groups have met regularly over the past 7 months and have formulated various recommendations that they plan to submit to the Commission for consideration at the end of May to move grid modernization forward in the District. We believe that it is important that the draft recommendations are widely disseminated and that all interested persons have sufficient opportunity to provide input.
