DCPSC Approves Modified Pepco Plug-In Vehicle Green Rider Tariff Rate

(Washington, D.C.) The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (Commission) has approved a reduced tariff rate for the Pepco's Plug-In Vehicle Green Rider (PIV-Green Rider). Pepco's filing reduced the rider tariff rate from \$0.02949 to \$0.02402. This rider is an optional component of Pepco's Time-of-Use Rate (R-PIV) that was created to assist customers with their energy costs by saving money on electric bills by charging electric vehicles (EVs) during off-peak hours when electricity prices are lower.

The PIV-Green Rider rate provides 100% renewable energy if the customer opts into Schedule R-PIV. This rider will be updated annually around February 1 and August 1 based on up-to-date market prices and the District of Columbia Renewable Portfolio Standards.

Interested District Pepco customers can <u>apply</u> for the Whole House Time-of-Use Rate, part of the utility's EVsmart program.
