The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia ("Commission") hereby gives notice that on September 3, 2020, the Potomac Electric Power Company ("Pepco") filed its Report on the Feasibility of Pepco to Implement Green Button Connect My Data in the District of Columbia ("Pepco's Report")¹ pursuant to the directives in Order No. 20364.² This Report addresses the feasibility of deploying Green Button Connect My Data ("CMD"), a method of providing secure access to customer energy usage data, in the District of Columbia. Pepco's Report addresses several Commission inquiries about CMD that were propounded in Order No. 20364.
