Pursuant to D.C. Code § 34-912(b)(2) and 15 D.C.M.R. 1300 *et seq.*, the Public Service Commission assesses telecommunications providers in the District of Columbia for the Commission and the Office of the People's Counsel's operating budget and monitors the level of competition in the District. Therefore, the Commission requires that each telecommunications provider serving the District complete the attached survey and provide a notarized affidavit to assure the accuracy of the reported information, such as gross jurisdictional revenue and the number of customers served and lines supplied.

More specifically, we require information on whether your company was supplying jurisdictional telecommunications services to end users in the District of Columbia as of December 31, 2018.

For the purpose of this survey, "gross jurisdictional revenue" is defined as gross revenues derived from operations regulated by the Commission in the District of Columbia, which does not include revenue derived from wireless, broadband, Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP), or Internet Protocol (IP)-enabled services. The gross jurisdictional revenue figure cannot be reduced by amounts such as, but not limited to, gross receipts taxes, delivery charges, surcharges, or pass through charges. Based on your company's gross jurisdictional revenue figures for calendar year 2018, the Commission will determine your company's applicable assessment for the fiscal year 2019 operating budgets of the Commission and the Office of the People's Counsel.

This year, we have enhanced our capability to accept confidential filings online, so that you can upload the confidential filing to the e-Docket. This means that now you have a choice to submit both public and confidential filings either via e-Docket or send them by mail. This new functionality became effective on February 6, 2019.

Please file your completed survey and attached affidavit with the Commission Secretary's office no later than April 1, 2019. Failure to submit the requested documents on time may subject the company to a penalty of \$100.00 for each day the filing is late, pursuant to 15 DCMR § 1301.3. If any of the provided information is confidential and proprietary, please clearly mark it as such.
