**NOTICE OF ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND ENERGY CONSERVATION  
TASK FORCE NOVEMBER 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020 MEETING**

**FORMAL CASE NO. 1148, IN THE MATTER OF THE INVESTIGATION INTO THE  
ESTABLISHMENT OF ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND ENERGY CONSERVATION  
PROGRAMS TARGETED TOWARDS BOTH AFFORDABLE MULTIFAMILY UNITS  
AND MASTER METERED MULTIFAMILY BUILDINGS WHICH INCLUDE LOW AND  
LIMITED INCOME RESIDENTS IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,**

On October 19, 2017, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) opened an investigation into the establishment and implementation of energy efficiency and energy conservation (“EEEC”) programs targeted towards both affordable multifamily units and master metered multifamily buildings, which include low- and limited-income residents in the District of Columbia as a result of the Exelon Corporation and Pepco Holdings, Inc. Merger Commitment set forth in Order No. 18148.<sup>1</sup> The Commission held numerous roundtables and working group meetings focused on implementing: (1) a Whole-Building, Deep Energy Retrofit Program (“Deep Retrofit Program”) targeted primarily towards both affordable multifamily units and master-metered multifamily buildings in the District, which include low- and limited-income residents; and (2) consumer education and outreach measures related to the implementation of the program.<sup>2</sup> On October 11, 2019, the Commission established the Energy Efficiency and Energy Conservation Task Force (“Task Force”) to prepare and issue a request for proposals to hire a recommended program Implementer to assist in finalizing the details and administration of the Deep Retrofit Program.<sup>3</sup> The Commission hereby gives notice that the EEEEC Task Force is scheduled to meet on November 4, 2020, from 1:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m.

The WebEx Event application will provide a separate link for the Task Force members allowing them to serve as panelists in the discussion. Through the moderated WebEx Event, only the hosts and the panelists have the ability to speak. The WebEx link and phone number provided below will allow the public to register to view the meeting. The public can only view and listen in on the discussion as all other features will be disabled.
