ESTABLISHMENT OF ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND ENERGY CONSERVATION
PROGRAMS TARGETED TOWARDS BOTH AFFORDABLE MULTIFAMILY UNITS
AND MASTER METERED MULTIFAMILY BUILDINGS WHICH INCLUDE LOW AND
LIMITED INCOME RESIDENTS IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,**

The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) hereby gives notice that the Energy Efficiency and Energy Conservation Task Force (“Task Force”) will hold a meeting on Thursday, May 27, 2021, from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. via WebEx. Pursuant to Commission Order No. 20663,¹ the Commission approved the Task Force’s recommendation to select the International Center for Appropriate & Sustainable Technology (“ICAST”) to be the implementer of a Whole-Building, Deep Energy Retrofit Program (“Deep Retrofit Program”) in the District of Columbia. As directed by Order No. 20663, the Task Force will continue discussion pertaining to ICAST’s 1st Quarter Report on the Deep Retrofit Program, among other things.²
