**FORMAL CASE NO. 1176, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF POTOMAC  
ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY FOR AUTHORITY TO IMPLEMENT A MULTIYEAR  
RATE PLAN FOR ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION SERVICE IN THE DISTRICT OF

1. The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) hereby gives notice that on December 19, 2025, Commission Staff filed the Lessons Learned Working Group Final Report (“LLWG Report”) in Formal Case No. 1176, pursuant to Order No. 22328.

2. The LLWG Report reflects the collaborative efforts of stakeholders throughout 2025 to identify areas of consensus and non-consensus and to propose recommendations for the Commission’s consideration and includes an evaluation framework intended to guide future proceedings involving alternative forms of regulation.

3. The Commission invites interested persons to submit written comments on the LLWG Report and the recommendations contained therein. Comments should address the evaluation framework, lessons learned, and any recommendations for future improvements to the multiyear rate plan case process. Interested persons may submit written comments on or before January 28, 2026.
