The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (Commission) informs interested persons of the opportunity to file supplemental comments in response to the Notice of Second Proposed Rulemaking (Second NOPR) published in the *D.C. Register* on September 26, 2025.¹ By Order No. 22734, the Commission allowed for a supplemental comment period of thirty (30) days after the Potomac Electric Power Company (Pepco) files the *Formal Case No. 1163 Standby Service Technical Conference Report* for parties to either supplement their existing comments or file new comments in response to the Second NOPR.² On March 23, 2026, Pepco filed the *Formal Case No. 1163 Standby Service Technical Conference Report*.³

2. Any person interested in supplementing their existing comments or filing new comments on this proposed rulemaking action may submit written comments not later than thirty (30) days after publication of this Notice in the *D.C. Register*. Comments are to be addressed to
