1. The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) hereby gives notice that, pursuant to Order No. 22719, at 2:00 PM on Thursday, January 15, 2026, the Commission will convene the second Senior Citizen and Disabled Residents Rate Credit (“Rider SCADRRC”) technical conference in the Commission Hearing Room to evaluate the impact and feasibility of continuing the Rider SCADRRC. The technical conference shall be hybrid in nature permitting in-person and virtual participation.

2. All persons interested in attending the technical conference shall register with the Commission Secretary by 5 PM EST on Friday, January 9, 2026.
