Offeror represents, warrants, and certifies that it and its employees engaged in the administration or performance of this Contract are knowledgeable of and understand the District of Columbia Government Ethics Act of 2011 (D.C. Code §§1-1162.01 1162.32). Offeror further represents, warrants, and certifies that neither Contractor nor any of its employees, or subcontractor will do any act that is inconsistent with such laws.
