Senior Citizens and Disabled Resident Credit

This January, seniors and individuals with disabilities may be eligible to receive a credit on their Pepco bill. The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia has approved a pilot program to assist seniors and disabled residents with their monthly payments.

HOW MUCH IS THE DISCOUNT?

\$7.50 credit per month on your Pepco electricity service.

WHEN IS THE CREDIT EFFECTIVE?

January 1, 2020

HOW WILL THE CREDIT BE APPLIED?

Enrollment is automatic and the credit will appear on your Pepco bill beginning in January and will continue each month.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

D.C. seniors and disabled persons receiving the D.C. Homestead Deduction and the Senior Citizen/Disabled Property Tax Reduction, and who do not receive the Pepco Residential Aid Discount (RAD).

If you are eligible for the credit and it doesn't appear on your bill, contact the Pepco Energy Assistance Team at 202-496-5830.
