INTRODUCTION

This guide has been prepared for the purpose of assisting attorneys who are interested in utility rate work. This particular legal area is generally neglected by law schools and potential employers do not recruit at the student level. As a consequence, there is widespread ignorance of the availability of positions in this field and of its potential for future growth. Such ignorance is particularly acute among Black members of the bar.

The information provided herein contains a brief description of the various roles and salaries of a rate attorney, a bibliography and listings of state regulatory bodies, consumer advocates and regulated utilities. These lists are limited to the following jurisdictions: California, District of Columbia, Georgia, Illinois, Maryland, Michigan, New York, Pennsylvania, and Wisconsin. However, a comprehensive listing of state and federal regulatory bodies is provided for convenience. The list of utilities however, is limited to major gas, electric and telephone utilities.

Most jurisdictions require that an attorney be licensed to practice in that jurisdiction, however, many states do have provisions for a special appearance upon motion to the Commission. Since there is virtually no recruitment done in the area of utility regulation, resumes or personal contact are the most widely employed and effective methods for obtaining employment.

Hopefully, this guide will provide a valuable source of information on opportunities in the field of utility law.

VARIOUS ROLES OF THE RATE ATTORNEY*

GENERAL COUNSEL/STAFF - (\$23,000 - \$35,000)

The Office of General Counsel is responsible for appeals, monitoring legislation, drafting opinions and orders and representing the Commission before judicial and other administrative bodies. However, the General Counsel's major responsibilities include providing advice to the Commission and representing the Commission Staff in rate proceedings. The Commission Staff consists of professional and technical experts who are trained as lawyers, economists, financial analysts, accountants, engineers and consumer affairs representatives.

LEGAL ASSISTANT TO A COMMISSIONER

Many Commissioners employ a legal assistant, who provides both technical and legal assistance to the Commissioner. Such assistance includes research, drafting memorandum, analyzing testimony, attending hearings and monitoring legislation.

ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE (ALJ) / HEARING EXAMINER - (\$25,000 - \$42,000)

In most jurisdictions, rate cases are heard by ALJ's or hearing examiners. The ALJ drafts a proposed opinion and order which is reviewed by the Commission who issues a final opinion and order.

CONSUMER ADVOCATE - (\$25,000 - \$50,000)

In many jurisdictions, the consumers/ratepayers are represented by a Consumer Advocate who has a staff of lawyers and technical experts.

RATE ATTORNEY (Utility \$25,000 - \$115,000) (Federal \$33,000 - \$50,000)

Many utilities employ a staff of attorneys who represent the utility before the Commission, however, the majority of utilities are represented by "outside" counsel.

A rate attorney employed by Federal agencies such as the Civil Aeronautics Board, Federal Energy Regulatory Commission and Federal Communications Commission has responsibilities similar to those of a general counsel.
